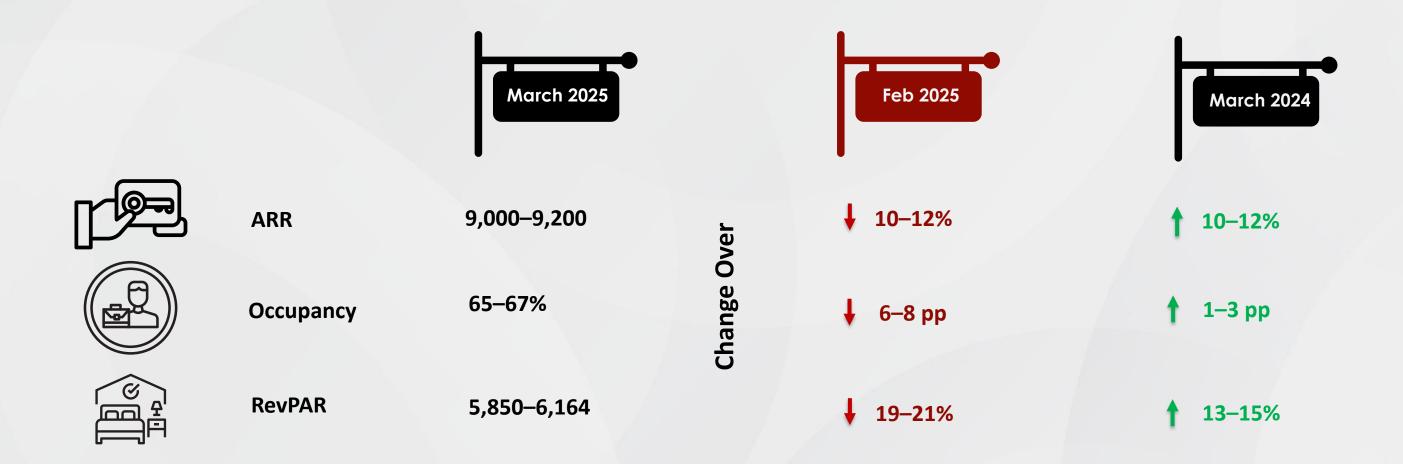




India Hotel Sector Performance

Following an exceptionally strong February, March 2025 marked a measured correction for the Indian hotel sector as performance eased month-on-month.

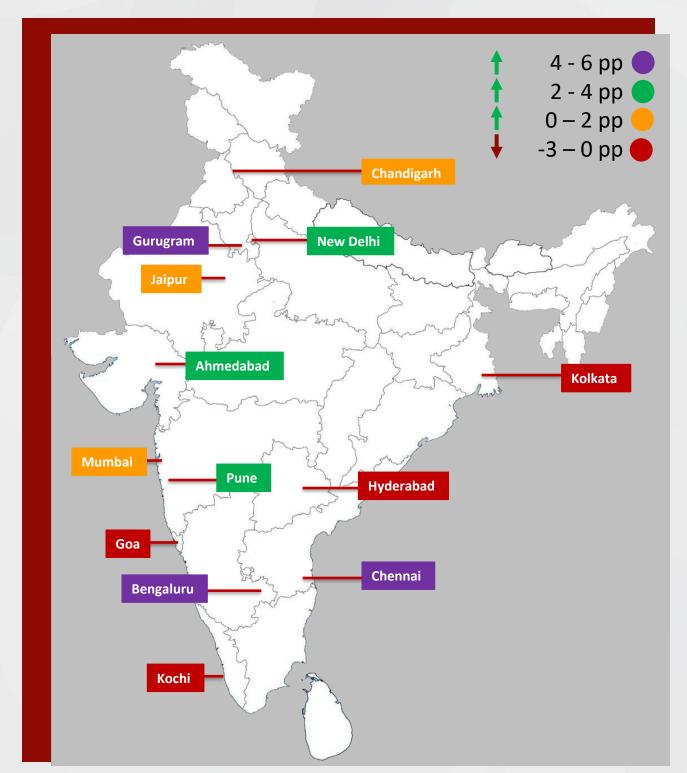




Occupancy Trends

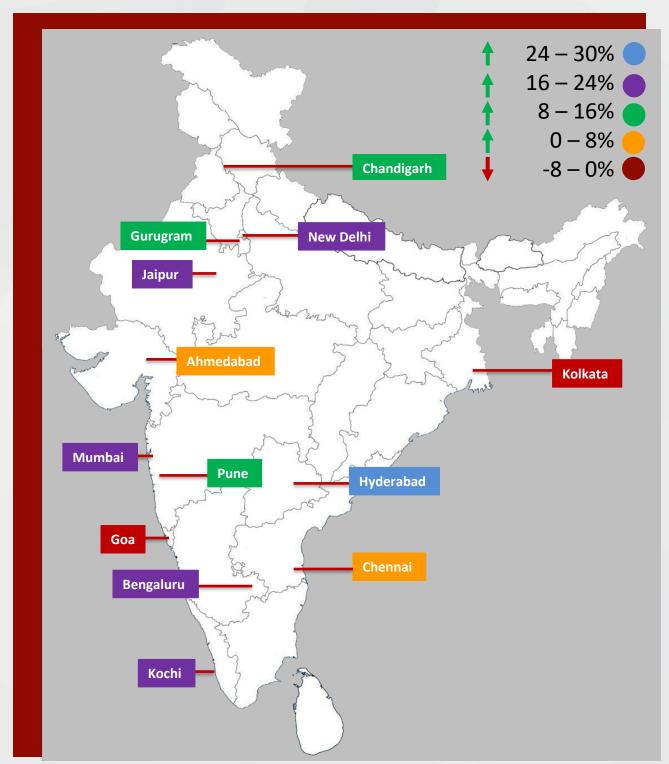


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ARR Trends

Branded Hotel Market Signings Analysis (YTD March 2025)

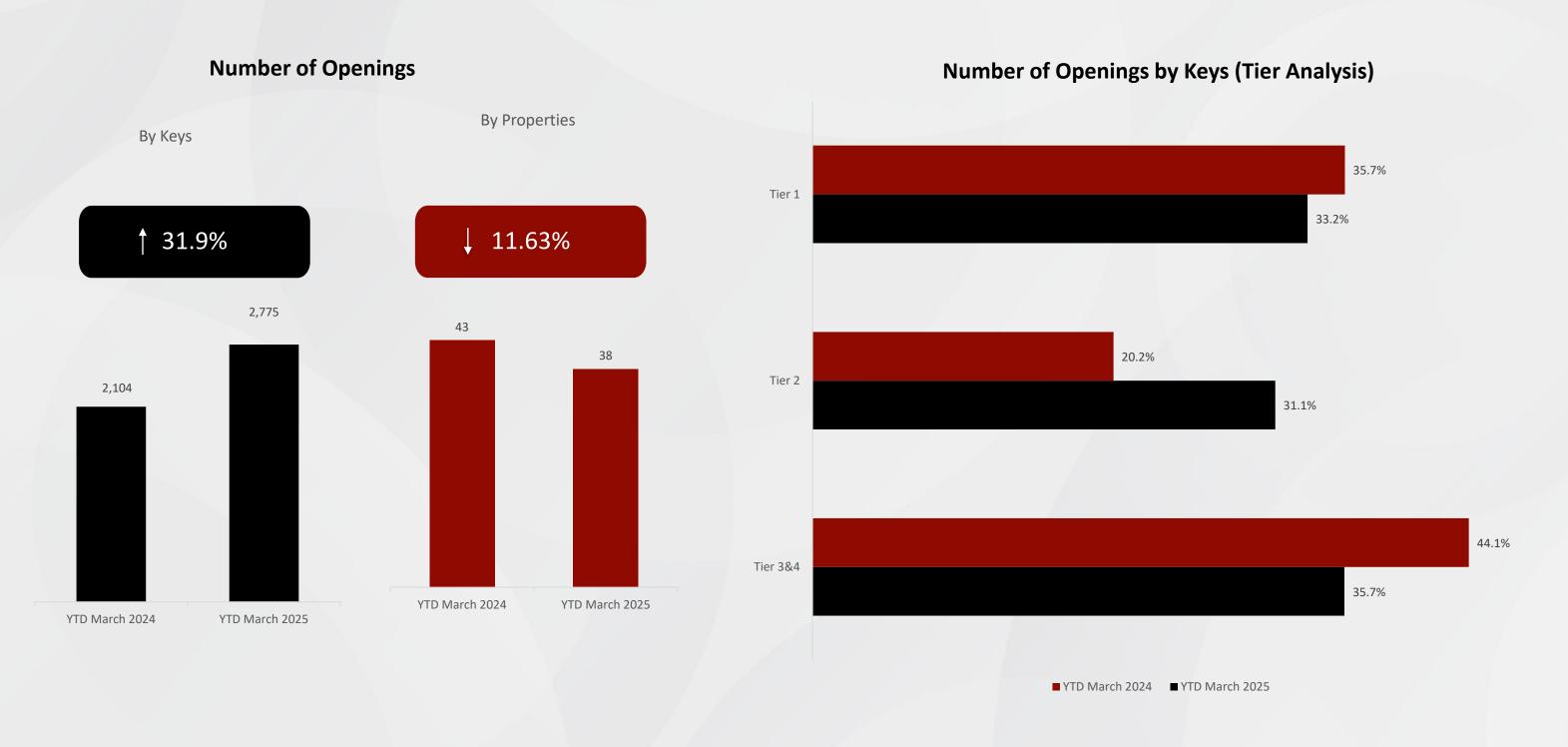

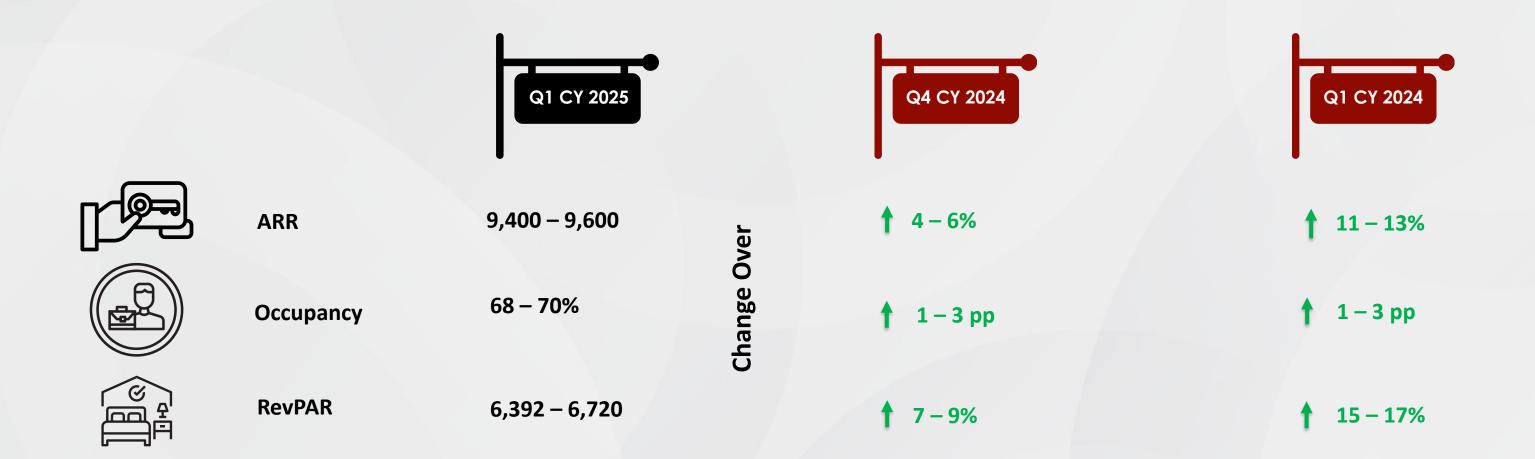




India Hotel Sector Performance

Compared to Q1 CY2024, all markets except Hyderabad recorded year-on-year occupancy growth, with the sharpest increases seen in Bengaluru.

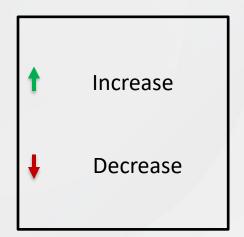




ARR Trend Across Key Indian Markets (Q1 CY2025)
