




India Hotel Sector Performance

(October 2025)

India's hotel sector witnessed robust performance in October 2025, with average room rates (ARR) rising by 10-12% year-on-year and the occupancy rate registering a slight increase. Demand was driven by a surge in corporate and MICE travel, while the extended Diwali weekend significantly boosted leisure bookings.








ARR Trends Across Key Indian Markets

(Year-on-Year Growth: October 2025)



- Average rates in October 2025 continued on their upward trajectory, with almost all major markets seeing double-digit growth.
- Bengaluru (+23-25%) and Hyderabad (+15-17%) emerged as the top gainers.



(Year-on-Year Growth: October 2025)




- Occupancy at the national level recorded a slight year-onyear improvement, reflecting steady performance despite ongoing regional variations.
- Jaipur saw the highest Y-o-Y growth in occupancy rates (6-8 percentage points), likely driven domestic leisure travel and higher inflow during festive season, cultural events and destination weddings.

Branded Hotel Market Signings Analysis (YTD October 2025)




